### ESSA Title 1, Part A – Improving Basic Programs

Grant Period: 9/1/2021-9/30/2022

Planning Amount: \$1,220,739

Provides supplemental resources to help schools with high concentrations of students from low-income families acquire the knowledge and skills in the state content standards and to meet the state student performance standards

### ESSA Title 1, Part C - Education of Migratory Children

Grant Period: 9/1/2021-9/30/2022

Planning Amount: \$4,574

Provides supplemental instructional and support services for migrant students and out of school migrant youth. Shared Services Agreement with Region 12 ESC

### ESSA Title II, Part A- Supporting Effective Instruction

Grant Period: 9/1/2021-9/30/2022

Planning Amount: \$181,379

Increase student achievement through improving teacher and principal quality and increasing the number of highly qualified teachers in classrooms and highly qualified principals in schools.

### ESSA Title III, Part A- English Language Acquisition and Language Enhancement
