

# ACTION FOR SIGNS AND AND SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19

Staff must be vigilant and call the school nurse or the designated administrative personnel immediately if a student or a staff member is displaying symptoms. If a staff member has been notified of a positive COVID-19 case at a student's or a fellow staff member's home they need to notify the appropriate administrative personnel.

If symptoms are suspected, isolate the student as safely as possible with minimum of 6 feet distance, apply face mask, and escort to the office or designated area of suspected ill persons.

**Symptoms: Fever, Cough (dry, productive, persistent), Shortness of Breath, nasal congestion, sore throat, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, fatigue, muscle aches, chills, and loss of taste or smell.**

  - Follow up
