

Emergency Plans

The superintendent and/or his designee has the responsibility for developing and maintaining emergency plans. The superintendent will supervise the operation of all school personnel in case of an emergency. Building principals will develop and be in charge of individual emergency plans for their buildings. Staff and students will be given instruction and practice the planned emergency procedures.

Emergency preparedness drills (bomb threats, fire, civil disturbance, intruder, severe weather, and/or tornado,) will be developed and conducted in accordance with state law.

A sufficient number of drills will be conducted to give instruction and practice in proper action to be taken by staff and students.

The decision for calling and executing drills will be the responsibility of the school principal or superintendent.

Close cooperation with other community agencies, fire department, police department, and civil defense, will be practiced.
