

## **Home Based Education**

**LBD**

The Board of Education encourages the enrollment of all children of school age in the district public schools or in an accredited private school, so that the child may enjoy the benefits of a well-planned educational program and the socialization possible in a group environment.

The Board recognizes its responsibility of assuring that every child of school age resident in the district is enrolled in an accredited school or is offered an equivalent thorough educational program elsewhere.

Parents desiring to establish a Home Based Education Program for their children shall submit a written statement to the Superintendent of Schools outlining a proposed curriculum as outlined in W.S. 21-4-101(a)(vi).

The Superintendent is charged with the responsibility of developing the necessary procedures to process such alternative educational requests and to coordinate those instances of transfer from alternative educational programs to the local public schools. Students transferring back into the public schools from alternative educational programs shall be received under Board Policy JEC, School Admissions.
