

## **COVID Return to School Procedures 2021-2022**

We are normally notified of a positive Covid test for a student by the parent or guardian, the Carbon County Public Health (CCPH) - usually by phone, or in some cases a doctor's office. Follow-up paperwork from CCPH which includes dates of onset and return normally lags a week or more.

Therefore, for those students who have to quarantine due to a positive Covid test, we will ask parents or guardians to produce a Dr's release - or written documentation from CCPH in order to return to school (similar to requirements following a concussion or other serious health issue). We simply do not have enough staff to constantly track down paperwork or health information from various entities - and most Dr.'s office are reluctant to release confidential patient information to school personnel. Thank you for your cooperation as we try to protect the well-being of our students and staff and get through this Covid situation.
