

## VPSB VIRTUAL SCHOOL UPDATE

In response to the recent developments related to the increased number of COVID-19 (delta variant) cases in Louisiana, VPSB has made the decision to:

- 1. Expand the existing virtual school program to K-3 students**
- AND**
- 2. Re-open the Virtual school application process for students in grades 4-12**

Applications will be available online ([www.vpsb.us](http://www.vpsb.us)) and at each school site. **The enrollment period will open at 12:00 noon on Tuesday August 10th and will close at 12:00 noon on Monday August 16th.**

All 2021-2022 virtual students (K- 12) will be required to maintain the academic integrity of the program by following the expectations below:

- Attending daily, live online instructional sessions with the virtual teacher •
- Maintaining access to high-speed reliable Internet
- Completing all assignments by the stated due dates
- Maintaining passing grades in all courses (progress monitored every 3 weeks) •
- Complying with all guidelines/expectations as stated in the Virtual School handbook •
- Using a VPSB Chromebook for all assignments / virtual instructional settings

\*\*\*Virtual School placement is for a 9-week period (minimum). Students may only change their academic setting 1 time during the instructional year.

\*\*\* Students will be removed from VPSB Virtual School at the discretion of the principal for failure to meet all virtual student expectations and/or due to failing grades.
