Summer has flown by and here we are waiting on the first day of classes!! The following are some frequently asked questions regarding the return of students and COVID-19. These updates were made after careful consideration of students and staff, as well as monitoring of state legislation.

### **Particular points of interests:**

**Masks-** In accordance with Oklahoma Senate Bill 658, masks will be optional for students and employees.

- In the event of a State of Emergency declaration by the governor, Madill Public School will consult with local and state health departments on any changes.

**Sick Students-** If a **student is sick or tests positive for COVID-19,** parents should keep the student at home and notify their school.

**Isolation/Quarantine-** Required for employees and students who have tested positive for COVID-19. People should stay home until it is safe for them to be around others. Symptoms will determine isolation and quarantine of those in close contact. If an employee/student has tested positive for COVID-19 and has symptoms, these are the guidelines for returning to school/work.

- At least 10 days since symptoms first appeared
- Fever free for 24 hours **without medication**
- Symptoms have improved
- Asymptomatic- If an employee/student has tested positive, they may return to work or school 10 days from the date of positive test.
- If a person is fully vaccinated and is exposed to COVID, quarantine is not warranted . Verification of vaccinations will not be regulated. We will ask that parents make responsible decisions in an effort to keep our children and staff safe.
- **Physical distancing-** will be promoted as much as possible. Contact tracing will continue in the classroom setting.
- **Cleaning Procedures** Madill will continue the disinfecting procedures and increase constant monitoring or affected classrooms or areas of exposure.
- **Educational Process-** Madill Public School will support all students with an educational program that best meets their needs. We believe that face to face instruction is best, but will have a committee ready to help you evaluate the educational needs of your students.

This is just a brief general overview of things that have to be fluid and constantly monitored.
