IDAB

Support program information approved by the board shall be filed with the clerk and made available to staff as needed.

Student Mental Health

The director may develop and implement a student mental health awareness program. The director shall identify community or area mental health agencies able to provide assistance if such services are not provided by the Interlocal in accordance with a student's I.E.P.

Dropout Prevention

To prevent students from dropping out of school or to encourage dropouts to return to school the Interlocal staff and administration will collaborate with each of the districts in the Interlocal to accomplish this goal.

Support Programs

The staff shall incorporate the philosophy and goals of this policy into the schools' programs.

Guidance

The Interlocal staff will work with the guidance staff in each building to provide appropriate guidance services all exceptional students served by the Interlocal.

Homebound Instruction

If a child is unable to attend school because of lengthy illness, injury, or disability, homebound instruction may be provided if:

The parent makes the request for homebound instruction; and

The Director or the student's IEP team recommend homebound placement, based on information indicating homebound instruction is medically necessary.
