

**JGG** Transportation (See ED and EDDA)

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Member districts are responsible for providing transportation of their special education students to and from the students' attendance centers or collection points at the times and on the days when school is being conducted by the member district. Transportation will be provided by the interlocal to such students as required for attendance for all extra-class activities hosted by the interlocal. Transportation may be denied to students who are detained after school for disciplinary reasons.

Students who use interlocal-provided transportation shall be under the jurisdiction of the vehicle driver while in the vehicle. Students shall be subject to the interlocal's student behavior code and other regulations developed by the director and approved by the board.

Interlocal drivers shall report violations of the rules to the building administrator who may discipline students. The administrator may suspend or revoke the transportation privilege of a student who violates any rule or regulation unless otherwise provided in the student's Individualized Education Plan.

When the interlocal provides transportation to an activity, participating students are prohibited from driving personal automobiles to and from interlocal-sponsored activities held during or after the school day.

All rules shall be published in the student handbook.
