In-Interlocal Employment

Students may be employed by the interlocal. The interlocal shall not employ students in hazardous jobs.

Outside Employment

A student who needs to work on a regular basis during the school day shall file a written request with the building administrator. If the request is approved, the student shall file a work schedule with the building administrator. Changes in the schedule shall be reported by the student to the administrator. The student shall not begin the new schedule unless the change is approved by the administrator.

Vocational or Other Work Experience

A student who works in a board-approved vocational or other work-experience program shall have a schedule developed interlocally by the employer and the supervising teacher and approved by the administrator prior to beginning the work activity.

All board policies remain applicable to students participating in vocational or other work experience programs.
