Community Eligibility Provision (CEP)

- A program provided by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA).
- All students in Bienville Parish receive meals at no charge each day, regardless of income.
- 5 breakfasts per week
- 5 lunches per week



Virtual Option (Phases 1, 2, & 3)

- Families that chose the virtual option are eligible for student meals provided by the Bienville Parish School Board.
- Will consist of 5 breakfasts and 5 lunches per week.
- Meals will be cold/frozen and can be prepared at the students' convenience during the week.
- Food safety handout will be provided for additional instruction.
- Principal of the students' regular school will determine meal pick up location, date, and time frame and will communicate that to families.
- This will continue as long as the virtual option is available.



Hybrid Model (Phase 2)

- Families that chose the hybrid option are eligible for meals provided by BPSB.
- Group A
 - students attend school on Mondays and Wednesdays
 - Eat “grab and go” breakfast meals in designated area
 - Lunch will be in covered, disposable containers that will be eaten in that site’s designated area
 - Remaining 3 breakfasts and 3 lunches will go home on Wednesday before the student leaves campus
 - Meals will be cold/frozen and can be prepared at the students’ convenience during the week.
 - Food safety handout will be provided for additional instruction.
 - Each student will receive a total of 5 breakfasts and 5 lunches per week



Hybrid Model (Phase 2)

- Families that chose the hybrid option are eligible for meals provided by BPSB.
- Group B
 - students attend school on Tuesdays and Thursdays
 - Eat “grab and go” breakfast meals in designated area
 - Lunch will be in covered, disposable containers that will be eaten in that site’s designated area
 - Remaining 3 breakfasts and 3 lunches will go home on Thursday before the student leaves campus
 - Meals will be cold/frozen and can be prepared at the students’ convenience during the week.
 - Food safety handout will be provided for additional instruction.
 - Each student will receive a total of 5 breakfasts and 5 lunches per week



Traditional Model (Phase 3)

- During Phase 3, students in the traditional model are eligible for meals provided by BPSB.
 - students attend school all five days each week
 - Eat “grab and go” breakfast meals in designated area
 - Lunch will be in covered, disposable containers that will be eaten in that site’s designated area
 - Each student will receive a total of 5 breakfasts and 5 lunches each week
 - This model provides no to go meals (only available for virtual students)
