Rules for all dress down days:

- No frayed, sagging, torn, or ripped pants
- No extremely wide legs
- No jeggings, hipsters, or low waist jeans
- No bleached or weathered jeans, no colored jeans – blue only
- No glittered or embroidered jeans
- No spaghetti strap shirts, muscle shirts, or tank tops
- No explicit writing or attitudinal comments on clothing
- No colored hair or extreme makeup
- No pajamas
- No flip-flops



If a student dresses down or wears jeans on the wrong day or does not follow the guidelines for dress down and jean days, they will call home for a school uniform and be issued a strike. Once a student has been issued three strikes, they will no longer be allowed to participate in any future dress down days for the remainder of the school year. Strikes are cumulative for all dress down days. Ex. Two strikes for violations on Winning Wednesday and one strike for jean day = the student will no longer participate in dress down or jean days.
