Dear Stakeholders,

On April 7, 2020, Dewar Public Schools will administer the ACT as our College and Career Ready Assessment to our eleventh grade students. The ACT is a standardized test used for college admissions in the United States. It is currently administered by ACT, a nonprofit organization of the same name. The ACT test covers four academic skill areas: English, mathematics, reading, and science reasoning. It also offers an optional direct writing test which Dewar Public Schools administers as well.

The ACT is approximately 3 hours and 35 minutes long and is given in two separate classrooms. Two test administrators and two test monitors are in the rooms at all times with breaks provided between each test. Each section of the ACT is scored on a 1 to 36 point scale. Your composite ACT score is the average of your four section scores, also on a scale from 1 to 36. A separate score is also provided for the writing portion of the ACT.

This letter is to inform our stakeholders of our test date as well as providing you an opportunity for any feedback you may wish to provide Dewar Public Schools.
