Presidio ISD is receiving Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) funds from the federal government via the Texas Education Agency. These funds are due to the COVID-19 pandemic which has impacted student learning. In response, the American Rescue Plan (ARP) was signed into law and it included \$122 billion for Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) funds for school districts across the country. The ARP is also referred to as ARP ESSER III or ESSER III.

Presidio ISD is applying to receive its share of ARP ESSER III (ESSER III) funding as determined by the Texas Education Agency (TEA). Presidio ISD is seeking feedback from all district and community stakeholders to help determine how the district should best utilize these resources to address unfinished learning, ongoing COVID-19 recovery, and Federal Program grant funds.
