On Monday, March 22, 2021, the Queen City ISD Board of Trustees approved a resolution that will make the wearing of masks optional for staff and students in school and at school sponsored events effective March 23, 2021. This decision was not made lightly but ultimately the board feels that individuals are able to make the best health and safety decisions for themselves and their families.

The district will allow teachers with health concerns the ability to require masks in their classrooms. The district will continue other disease mitigation practices, including social distancing where feasible, frequent hand washing, and enhanced cleaning processes.
