On Monday, April 12, 2021 the Board of Trustees met at our regular meeting and discussed Southland ISD COVID protocols. After much discussion, the board approved a resolution that makes the wearing of masks optional for staff and students at school. The one exception is that a teacher or driver may require a student to wear a face covering when the student is within six feet of the teacher or driver. Failure to comply with that request would be considered insubordination and subject to the Student Code of Conduct.

While this decision was not made lightly, ultimately the board feels that individuals are able to make the best health and safety decisions for themselves and their families.

Wearing a mask remains a personal choice that will be respected here at Southland. Any staff member or student who chooses to wear a face mask will be fully supported in their decision.

We will continue to keep the safety of our SISD community as our top priority.
