\$450,000 Combined Purpose Bonds of 2015, dated May 1, 2015 (\$250,000 outstanding in principal as of the 2nd day of April, 2019); and  
\$2,360,000 Building Bonds of 2015, dated May 1, 2015 (\$1,925,000 outstanding in principal as of the 2nd day of April, 2019).

**Detailed Description of the Use of Previous Bond Proceeds:**

2015 Combined Purpose Bonds

Acquire and install technology equipment \$150,000.00

Acquire vehicles for pupil transportation \$300,000.00

2015 Building Bonds

Construct, furnish, equip, renovate and/or remodel a high school building (1205 South Brooks Road, Marlow, Oklahoma), a portion of which to be constructed as a safe room \$2,360,000.00
