## *Criteria*

**This scholarship is to encourage the "B" - "C" student. The scholarship is open to senior students of any race or gender. Students should be involved in school and community service-related group. To be eligible for the Okmulgee Alumni Room Scholarship, a student must meet the following criteria:**

1. Have been an Okmulgee High School student for at least two years;
2. Have the personal recommendation of his/her counselor;
3. Have a minimum grade point average of 2.5;
4. Have a minimum ACT score of 18;
5. Have good character with leadership ability;
6. Must maintain a college grade point average of 2.5 or above on a scale of 4.0.

In addition to the above guidelines, each person wishing to be considered will submit the scholarship application form to the Okmulgee Alumni Room Scholarship Committee.

This scholarship will be payable to the recipient and their college/university once they have enrolled and receive their class schedule, which must be submitted to the committee.

The scholarship will be announced annually by one of the committee members at the Senior Awards Night. The committee will choose the recipient and notify the student of their selection.
