

Okmulgee Service League Scholarship Application

Rules and Regulations

For Okmulgee County High School Seniors desiring to attend
Oklahoma State University Institute of Technology (OSUIT)

OR

Okmulgee County High School Seniors that are children/grandchildren of
Okmulgee Service League active members/sustaining members

(Revised 4/8/2019)

1. Four scholarships to be awarded annually by the Okmulgee Service League, if in the opinion of the committee, acceptable and eligible applicants are proposed. Two scholarships to OSUIT applicants, valued at \$750 each, and two scholarships to children/grandchildren of OSL active/sustaining members, valued at \$750 each.
2. To be eligible, an applicant must be either:
 - a. One must be a Senior graduating from an Okmulgee County high school. These scholarships are applicable only to education at Oklahoma State University Institute of Technology, Okmulgee, OK.

OR

 - b. The applicant must be a child or grandchild of either an active or sustaining Okmulgee Service League member in good standing. The applicant must be a Senior graduating from an Okmulgee County high school preparing for their freshman year of college.
3. Scholarships are to be awarded primarily on scholastic record and sincere desire to pursue a higher education degree. Other important factors to be considered are leadership, extracurricular activities, community involvement, and moral standing and reputation.
4. Both the OSUIT Scholarship and the OSL Scholarship will be payable to the graduating Senior student once it has been officially awarded.
5. The Scholarship Committee of the Okmulgee Service League shall have full powers and jurisdiction in making the awards. They may adopt any procedure they deem advisable, and request information records and suggestions from school authorities, parents and others, in the course of their deliberations, and without any delegation of duty or responsibility.
6. **Deadline:** Applications must be postmarked no later than April 1st. Please mail applications along with a high school transcript to:
