

COVID-19 Protocol for Schools in Southeast Oklahoma

Daily Screening:

1. Parents will screen their youngster before they come to school verifying they are certified healthy. The checklist is attached.
2. All students, parents, and staff will have their temperature checked daily before they enter the school or bus. If a student, parent, or staff member has a temperature of 100.0 degrees or higher, they will not be allowed onto the bus or into the building. These are the guidelines that the CDC has established for us to follow. We apologize for any inconvenience that this may cause.

At School Procedures:

1. If a student has COVID symptoms and/or a temperature of 100.0 degrees or higher, they will be placed in an isolation room until their parent or someone designated on their checkout list can get them.
2. After being sent home, the student cannot return to school until one of the following criteria is met:
 - A) Without COVID testing, the student must not be present at school for 10 days.
 - B) After a negative COVID test, the student or staff member can return to physical school after 3 days of being fever free with no fever reducing medication.
 - C) The student will become a distance learner at home until he/she can return to school.
 - D) The student will be counted as present because digital learning will be provided.

Bus Transportation:

1. Recommend alternate transportation if possible for all bus riders (If you are concerned about your students riding the bus, bring them to school.)
2. Seating chart required.
3. Maximize air flow (Windows down when possible.)

*Parents:

- Until further notice, only Pre-3 and Pre-K parents will be allowed to walk their student to class after they stop by the office and get a visitor tag.
- Water bottles and/or water containers are recommended for students to drink. At this time, our water fountains will be turned-off due to the Coronavirus. We will have bottled water for students. You can send water bottles and/or containers with your student if you want to do that.
- At this time, it is **recommended** that students, faculty, and visitors wear a face mask.
