The district has received grant funds administered through the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) Fund. Through this grant process the district has received 486,063.05 in ESSER 3.0 funds. The district has identified four major areas of need. These areas are: addressing learning loss related to Covid 19 school closures and interruption of services; addressing the needs of special populations; addressing health and wellness including Covid 19 health protocols and procedures, mental health needs, and physical health needs of students and staff; and addressing the needs in school facilities across the district.
