

Eligibility for Extracurricular Activities

For the 2021-2022 School year LISD has adopted a 9 week grading period. We are required to follow UIL guidelines for eligibility purposes. Please read the policy below followed by important dates to be informed concerning eligibility dates. I have also included 2 links for UIL that address this matter if you have questions.

UIL grading guidelines, the first six weeks of the school year will serve as our first grading eligibility date. Since we compete in UIL, we must follow this policy even though we're on an annual 9-week grading cycle. The progress report date for the 1st six-week grading period is Sept. 24th. Students can regain or lose eligibility on this date, even though this is not the end of the 9 week grading period. Grades will be due to be submitted by Sept. 27th at noon. Progress reports will go out on Thursday, Sept. 30th. Students will have the ability to regain eligibility on Oct. 8th at the end of the 9-week grading cycle.
