

TAX RATE RESOLUTION FOR 2021-2022
Hudson ISD

Authority: Section 26.05(b) of Property Tax Code

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE TAX RATE FOR THE **HUDSON INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT**, ANGELINA COUNTY, TEXAS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING ON THE 1ST DAY OF SEPTEMBER 2021 AND ENDING ON THE 31ST DAY OF AUGUST 2022.

This year's proposed tax rate exceeds the no-new-revenue tax rate. The vote on the ordinance, resolution, or order setting the tax rate must be a record vote. A motion to adopt the ordinance, resolution, or order must be made in the following form:

MOTION: "I move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$1.136700, which is effectively a 3.99 percent increase in the tax rate. This total tax rate of \$1.136700 is composed of an M&O rate of \$0.964700 and an I&S rate of \$0.172000 as per resolution.

On this date, we, the Board of Trustees of the Hudson Independent School District, hereby levy or set the tax rate on \$100 valuation for the District for the tax year 2021 at a rate of **\$1.136700** to be assessed and collected by the duly specified assessor and collector as follows.

\$0.964700 for the purpose of Maintenance and Operations, and
\$0.172000 for the purpose of payment of principal and interest on debts.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Hudson Independent School District did on the 19th day of August, 2021, adopt the tax rate of \$1.136700 (M&O \$0.964700 and I&S \$0.172000) by a record vote of 6 ayes and 0 nays and;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE HUDSON INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT, ANGELINA COUNTY, TEXAS, THAT THE TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING ON THE 1ST DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2021 AND ENDING ON THE 31ST DAY OF AUGUST, 2022 SHALL BE AND IS \$1.136700 (M&O \$0.964700 AND I&S \$0.172000).


PASSED AND APPROVED THIS 19th DAY OF AUGUST, 2021.
