

BOARD POLICIES UNDER
SECTION L -- INTERORGANIZATIONAL RELATIONS

LA Goals and Objectives

The board will seek to establish a satisfactory working relationship with governmental and private agencies having an interest in the operation of public schools.

LB School-Community Cooperation

The board will seek to foster an atmosphere of cooperation between the schools and community groups and organizations.

LC School-Community Program

The board will consider the establishment of programs sponsored jointly by the district and community groups or organizations whenever, in the judgment of the board, such programs cannot be or should not be wholly under the control of the board.

LDD Federal Government-Drug Free Schools

The unlawful possession, use, or distribution of illicit drugs and alcohol by students or school employees on school premises or as a part of any school activity is prohibited. This policy, and any curriculum used in conjunction with it, shall be evaluated at least every-other year using criteria developed by the superintendent and approved by the board. The board shall receive a report after each of these reviews is conducted. (See IDA, GAOA, GAOB, and JDDA)

LED Family Night

On Wednesdays, no school related events may be scheduled to begin after 6:00 p.m. or which extend beyond 7:00 p.m. No events may be scheduled on Sundays without the administration's permission.
