## AMANDA SMITH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

**AMOUNT:** \$500

**GENERAL STATEMENT:** Scholarship will be presented to a young woman who plans to complete her education through a college or technical/vocational school program. The Smith family will choose recipient

**CRITERIA:**

1. Personal and academic qualifications
2. Financial need
3. At least one year successfully completed in LISD cheerleading program



## AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF UNIVERSITY WOMEN (AAUW) SCHOLARSHIP

**AMOUNT:** \$1000 (One-Time Only)

**GENERAL STATEMENT:** The purpose of this scholarship is to encourage young women to pursue higher levels of education. The scholarship money will be awarded to the recipient upon proof of enrollment in the college of her choice.

**CRITERIA:**

1. Senior girl
2. Financial need
3. Graduating in the top half of the class
4. Personal qualifications: high moral character, commitment to completing a college education
5. Applicant will use the official School/Club/Organization scholarship application
6. Teacher appraisal



## ANNELIESE HARTMANN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

**AMOUNT:** 1 @ \$1,000

**GENERAL STATEMENT:** This scholarship is \$500 per semester. The scholarship will be given to a graduating Livingston High School student with considerable financial need and is available upon enrollment in an accredited university/college or technical/vocational school. This could be ongoing for the same student on a semester to semester basis dependent on academic standing.

**CRITERIA:**

1. Financial need
2. Four year attendance at Livingston High School



## BRADLY CURRIE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

**AMOUNT:** 1 Based on funds

**GENERAL STATEMENT:** This scholarship will be given to one graduating senior who is in good academic standing and is pursuing a form of higher education to a CHEA school.

**CRITERIA:**

1. Be in good standing at school;
2. Be academically qualified;
3. Accepted at a college, university or technical/vocational school.



## BRIAN PERRY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

**AMOUNT:** Varies

**GENERAL STATEMENT:** Each scholarship will be presented to high school graduates who plan to complete his/her education through a college or technical/vocational school program.

**CRITERIA:**

1. Personal and academic qualifications
2. Financial need

# CHI ST. LUKE'S HEALTH - LIVINGSTON

## VOLUNTEER AUXILIARY SCHOLARSHIP

**AMOUNT:** \$1000 - (\$500 per semester)

**GENERAL STATEMENT:** The applicant must provide the scholarship committee with proof of registration to a Texas college or university, a transcript of grades for first semester of their senior year, a notarized statement of desire by the student to enter into the medical field of study. If all requirements are met, the applicant could be awarded \$1000. The award is paid in installments of \$500 deposited in student school account.

**CRITERIA:**

1. The applicant must maintain a 3.0 GPA and carry at least 12 hours per semester
  2. He/She must attend a fall or spring semester
  3. Scholarships are renewable if requirements are met, up to four (4) years
  4. Major in a medical field area

## DOROTHY JAGGERS HURT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

**AMOUNT:** 2 @ \$750

**GENERAL STATEMENT:** Each scholarship is awarded to a college-bound LHS senior who has demonstrated motivation, strong leadership qualities, and a realization of the importance of service to others through school, church, and/or community activities. The scholarship committee may show favoritism toward, but not be tied to, a member of the Presbyterian Church of Livingston. The recipients of these scholarships will be chosen by the LHS at-large scholarship selection committee.

**CRITERIA:**

1. Graduated in the top 10% of his/her class
  2. Financial need
  3. Have high morals/good character
  4. Must be in good standing in school and community

## E GARY MORRISON (1931) FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

**AMOUNT:** 2 @ \$1,000 (\$500 per semester)

**GENERAL STATEMENT:** This scholarship will be given to a graduating senior who is in good academic standing and is pursuing a degree at an accredited college, university, or technical/vocational.

**CRITERIA:**

1. One scholarship is to be awarded to one (1) boy and one (1) girl
  2. Recipients must acknowledge receipt of scholarship with a "thank you" letter or note to Ms. Patricia Ann Morrison with details of what college they are attending.
  3. Be in good standing with school and community
  4. Acceptance to an accredited college, university, or technical/vocational.

## E. HARLAN COCHRAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

**AMOUNT:** \$1000

**GENERAL STATEMENT:** A graduating senior who has participated in the LHS Drama program must make application for this scholarship. A committee of three high school faculty members including current Drama teacher, and a teacher of their choice will make the selection. Student may attend any technical/vocational or collegiate institution, pursuing any major. Funded by First National Bank of Livingston.

**CRITERIA:**

1. Personal qualifications: character, commitment, and cooperation
  2. Financial need
  3. Academic qualifications

## ELLEN V. JONES MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

**AMOUNT:** 1 @ \$500

**GENERAL STATEMENT:** This scholarship is to be given to a graduating senior who is in good academic standing and is pursuing a history or education degree at an accredited college or university.

**CRITERIA:**

1. Financial need
2. Be in good standing at school and in community
3. Academic qualifications

To receive this scholarship, seniors must:

1. Complete the Fall 2021 semester at a college/university as a full-time student with a 3.0 + GPA
2. Enroll for the Spring 2022 semester as a full-time student
3. Submit to LISD the requested information in January 2022.

## ERNEST E. COCHRAN FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

**AMOUNT:** 2 at \$1000 each

**GENERAL STATEMENT:** Given to two graduating students with major financial needs who have previously demonstrated they are highly motivated and dedicated to gaining skills that will provide them with a successful career. The awards could go to individuals attending technical/vocational training programs or regular college.

**CRITERIA:**

1. High morals and character
  2. Leadership - work preparation for career
  3. Academic qualifications

## ESCAPEES RV CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

**AMOUNT:** 1 @ \$500, funding permitting

**GENERAL STATEMENT:** This scholarship is for a student with major financial needs and is available upon enrollment in college/university or technical/vocational school. It is intended for a student who has demonstrated a sincere interest in gaining skills that will provide him/her with a successful career.

**CRITERIA:**

1. Motivation
  2. Preference given to students currently working at Escapees, Inc.

## EXCEPTIONAL EMERGENCY CENTER SCHOLARSHIP

**AMOUNT:** Varies

**GENERAL STATEMENT:** This scholarship will be given to a graduating senior who is in good academic standing and is pursuing a medical or health care degree at an accredited college or university.

**CRITERIA:**

1. Be in good standing at school and in the community;
  2. Academic Qualifications;
  3. Acceptance to a credited college or university;
  4. Financial need.

## FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF LIVINGSTON

**AMOUNT:** 2 @ \$1,000

**GENERAL STATEMENT:** This scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who has been accepted to an accredited college, university or technical/vocational school. It is intended for a student who has demonstrated motivation, strong leadership qualities and a realization of the importance of service to others through school and/or community activities.

**CRITERIA:**

1. Financial need
  2. Complete a semester at a college/university with a minimum 2.5 GPA
  3. Enroll the following semester as a full time student
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## FIRST STATE BANK ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

**AMOUNT:** 4 @ \$500

**GENERAL STATEMENT:** This scholarship is designed to reward students who demonstrate effort and commitment in completing their education. Students who apply for this scholarship will receive an award letter in May 2021 on Community Honors night explaining what they need to do in order to receive the scholarship funds in January 2022.

**TO RECEIVE THE SCHOLARSHIP, SENIORS MUST:**

1. Complete the application in this book and graduate from LHS in June 2021
2. Complete the Fall 2021 semester at a college/university with a 2.0 + GPA
3. Submit to LISD the requested information in January 2022.  
and
4. Enroll for the Spring 2022 semester as a full-time student  
or
5. Be a full-time technical/vocational student who successfully completes, by January 2022, 3 months or more of an 8 month course of study.

# FLORIDA'S KITCHEN AFRICAN-AMERICAN ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP

**AMOUNT:** Varies

**GENERAL STATEMENT:** With studies showing a steady decrease in the numbers of African-American males and females enrolling, and/or completing their college coursework, it has become essential for the African-American Community to promote the importance of life-long learning through education. The Florida's Kitchen African-American Achievement Scholarship, is awarded to any African-American student, (male or female), who is active in extra-curricular activities and currently enrolled at Livingston High School.

**CRITERIA:**

1. Applicant must be in good standing with the school and community, with a minimum of a 2.5 GPA
2. Must have already been accepted to a 4 year university, with plans to attend.
3. **Each applicant must type a 750 word double spaced essay answering this question:**  
"Why is it important for all African-Americans to receive a college education?"



## GREEN & WHITE FFA SCHOLARSHIP

**AMOUNT:** Varies

**GENERAL STATEMENT:** This scholarship goes to a graduating FFA senior who has been involved in the active pursuits of agriculture.

**CRITERIA:**

1. Member of Livingston FFA for two or more years
2. Earned their LoneStar degree
3. Use GPA to choose between finalist



## HARRISON SCHOLARSHIP

**AMOUNT:** 1 @ \$500

**GENERAL STATEMENT:** This scholarship is to be given to a graduating senior who is in good academic standing and is pursuing an engineering degree at an accredited college or university.

**CRITERIA:**

1. Financial need
2. Be in good standing at school and in community
3. Academic qualifications

To receive this scholarship, seniors must:

1. Complete the Fall 2021 semester at a college/university as a full-time student with a 3.0 + GPA
2. Enroll for the Spring 2022 semester as a full-time student
3. Submit to LISD the requested information in January 2022.



## HEALTH PROFESSIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

**AMOUNT:** \$500

**GENERAL STATEMENT:** The scholarship goes to a graduating senior with a major in a health related occupation (physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy, nursing, pre-med) at an approved college or university.

**CRITERIA:**

1. Be in good standing at school and in the community
2. Overall grade must be in the top 15%
3. Requires recommendations from teachers or professional person



## HELM FAMILY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

**AMOUNT:** 1 @ \$500

**GENERAL STATEMENT:** This scholarship will be given to one graduating senior who has met physical and or academic challenges and would like to pursue additional education.

**CRITERIA:**

1. Financial need;
2. Acceptance to an accredited college or university or technical/vocational school;
3. Personal qualifications; character, commitment, and cooperation.

## JOHN AND MARTHA STUBBS OPPORTUNITY SCHOLARSHIP

AMOUNT: 5 @ \$1000

**GENERAL STATEMENT:** This scholarship is awarded to a graduating LHS senior based on a combination of several factors including: financial need, work experience, academic performance, and challenges overcome. Average academic performance should not prevent an application from applying if she/he meets the other criteria listed.

**CRITERIA:**

1. Financial Need
  2. Be in good standing with school and community
  3. Academic performance balanced against challenges overcome
  4. Acceptance to an accredited college or university or vocational school
  5. List work experience in out-of-school activities section of application
  6. Must include a separate 100-200 word essay on challenges you have overcome.

3. Must have completed 12 years in the LISD school system, or be the legacy of a parent who formally graduated from LHS.



## LHS UIL ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

**AMOUNT:** \$100 or more (Based on available money)

**GENERAL STATEMENT:** Members of the UIL Academic Scholarship Committee will select the scholarship recipients from applications for scholarship assistance.

**CRITERIA:**

1. Qualifications include UIL success, academic program commitment, district participation in current year's contest and number of academic events participated in.
2. Personal qualifications include no major discipline problems during high school years.
3. Student must complete a UIL scholarship application by the required date.



## LIVINGSTON ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

**AMOUNT:** Varies
